A good committee has been formed with the Lions with lots of planning still ahead. The first speaker, Ray Charbonneau will talk about art restoration and art history after the Inauguration of the Friendship Arch on April 12th.

Treasurer's Report: Ian reported that the Wi-Fi extender will soon be installed on the Barrie Hall allowing the Museum to finally have a reliable Wi-Fi connection. It will also provide free Wi-Fi to areas around the Barrie Community Hall. Ian also explained the Endowment Fund.
